**DESCRIPTION OF OCCURRENCE:**

On 2/11/11 the facility determined that 905 units of Lantus were missing.

**FACILITY ACTION:**

The facility conducted an internal investigation. The facility notified the physician. The medication had been prescribed for a female patient, in her 50s. The bottle of Lantus [long acting insulin] was marked as being opened February 10 (marked to expire 3/15). the patient's order was Lantus 35 units at 11:00 AM, and 40 units at 11:00 PM. On 2/11/11 when drawing up 2300 dose, only 20 units were left in the bottle. Since 2/10/11, the patient had only received 75 units. 905 units of Lantus was missing and unaccounted for." The bottle was 100 units per milliliter and was 10 milliliters (1000 units total). The facility believes that the pharmacist had brought the bottle up to the unit already opened (perhaps opened prior to 2/10). The the bottle was incorrectly labeled as well since 28 days from 2/10 would be 3/10, not 3/15. The facility could not account for the 905 units of insulin that were missing.

**DEPARTMENT FINDINGS:**

The Department conducted an onsite investigation on 5/16 - 19/11 and cited the facility for failure to report this occurrence. The Department will review this occurrence prior to any survey or upon receipt of any complaint that may be filed against this facility.
