Dear Mr. Seal:

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) notified you on February 18, 2015, that your hospital, Texoma Medical Center, no longer meets the requirements for participation in the Medicare program because of deficiencies that represent an immediate jeopardy to patient health and safety. The Medicare provider agreement of your hospital was scheduled for termination on March 20, 2015.

On February 26, 2015, we received your request to enter into a Systems Improvement Agreement with CMS in order to stay the termination action and provide you the opportunity to develop and implement systemic correction at your hospital with the assistance of independent consultative experts. We have accepted your offer.

Therefore, we are extending the termination date of your hospital from the Medicare/Medicaid program to allow for the development and finalization of that agreement. The termination date is extended to **April 20, 2015**.

We plan to publish notice of this termination in **The Herald Democrat** on **April 3, 2015**. We will also notify the appropriate State officials concerning termination of your provider agreement under Title XVIII because the requirements for participation in the Medicaid program are substantially the same as those for Medicare.
